



All participants in Poietics Donor Programs Must Meet the Following Criteria:

- Healthy males and non-pregnant females 18 and over.
- Negative clinical laboratory tests for HIV, hepatitis B and hepatitis C.
- Normal vital signs and normal hematology (VBC) values.
- Weight not greater than 10% above the normal body weight for height.
- No blood or bleeding disorders, or abnormal scarring tendencies.
- No prescription medications other than those deemed allowable by the medical professional interviewing the donor, such as birth control pills.
- Minimum of eight weeks from bone marrow donations or participation in other donor programs.
- Donors may only donate a maximum of four times per calendar year and six donations total.
- Signed and witnessed informed consent forms.
- Negative medical history for heart disease, kidney disease, cancer, bleeding ulcers, diabetes, jaundice, liver disease, hepatitis and epilepsy.
- Negative medical history for bacterial or viral infections which may be hazardous to the researchers.
- No non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs, aspirin or dietary supplements containing aspirin, within five days of the donation or for two days following the donation.

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
